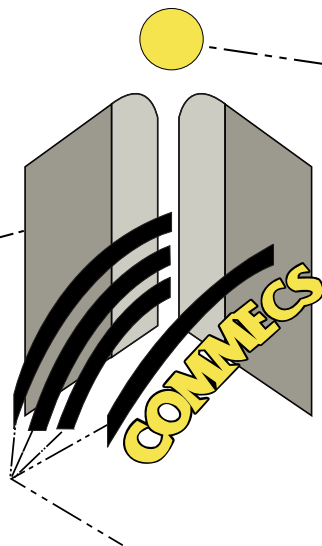

## Commeccs College–An Overview

The Foundation Stone of Commeccs Institute of Business Education (CIBE) was laid in 1988. An extensive fund-raising campaign was launched and land was purchased in Gulistan-e-Jauhar, Karachi. A purpose-built three-storey building with a covered area of 1.24 acres was inaugurated by the then Sindh Governor, Late Hakim Mohammed Said, on September 15, 1993. The campus facilities are dedicated in the name of donors.

In 2003, Pre-engineering discipline was introduced necessitating a change in name from Commeccs Institute of Business Education (CIBE) to Commeccs Institute of Business and Emerging Sciences (CIBES). Subsequently Pre-Medical and Computer Science programs were also launched and CIBES were converted into two institutions; The CIBES itself and the Commeccs College. All Intermediate study programs came under Commeccs College. In pursuit of more fruitful contribution to the society, Commeccs College introduced Humanities discipline in 2021.

Campus facilities include comfortable air-conditioned classrooms equipped with multimedia, a high-tech Computer laboratory, Physics, Chemistry and Biology laboratories, a well-stocked library, a spacious auditorium, training room, prayer hall, cafeteria, tuck shop, girls common room and indoor sports facilities.

## FULLY AUTOMATED LIBRARY

Libraries play a vital role in the development of intellectual abilities. These are treasure houses of knowledge for students and teachers alike to draw maximum benefit.

An independent quest for knowledge is one of the most important aspects of learning. At Commeccs Library, an Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) is used for book searching. Internet is available for students to search sites for their assignments.

At Commeccs College, where great stress is laid on “Excellence in Education”, the fully automated Library meets the latest standards, covering a wide range of subjects including Natural and Social Sciences, Languages and Literature, Philosophy, Psychology, Mathematics, Communication, Religion, History, Biology, Physics, Chemistry

and Computer Science. National and International magazines, journals and periodicals are also subscribed.

### Auditorium

Commeccs College has a spacious auditorium with an adequate seating capacity. The auditorium is equipped with a built-in sound system. Seminars, Talk Shows, Debates, Quiz Competitions, Stage Shows and Guest Speaker Sessions are organized regularly to provide a healthy learning environment to the students of Commeccs College.



## Commeecs Facilities

### Common Room / Indoor Games Room

A well-furnished Common Room allows girls to spend their free time and offer prayers. There is a separate in-door games room for boys and girls to spend their spare time. The rooms have facilities for Scrabble, Chess, Carrom and Table Tennis. Students practice these sports for participation in annual matches.

### Sports Facilities

Apart from in-house sports facilities, prestigious locations like Jahangir Khan Squash Complex, Customs Club and National Sports Board Coaching Centre are booked for various annual events. The annual Students' Week and the Sports Gala are intrinsic features to keep the promise of providing a comprehensive educational and developmental package.

### TRANSPORT

Transport facility is provided through a selected contractor. The present fleet consists of more than 43 vehicles that provide transport to students from almost every nook and corner of the city.



### COMMECS PARK

Commeccs serves society through its public service initiatives in educational and social sectors. The Commeccs Park adopted in 2002 is one such community service. It has added beauty to the environment and provided ample space for some of the activities of the college.





## Students' Academic & Developmental Support

The College provides students an environment of high creativity and versatility by motivating them to give an objective account of happenings around them. Alongwith a sound educational experience in a congenial learning environment, we strive to inculcate strong cultural, moral and social values in students.

**The Entire Commeccs College Campus is a No-Smoking Zone:**

**Character Building:** Character building is an integral part of Commeccs College culture. We aim at developing the 'whole person' - an upright and contributing citizen and not just a successful professional. Special emphasis is laid on inculcating diligence, integrity, courtesy, credibility, confidence, honesty and discipline by providing students opportunities for a successful academic experience. In this regard, a Character Building Society has been established under senior faculty members and selected students. It plans activities and programs related to character building.



**Student Counselling:** Career counseling is a salient feature of Commeccs College culture. A students counselor has been appointed to provide counselling and guidance to students in academic and emotional domains. Corporate sector experts are invited to give directions and guidelines for future academic and professional pursuits. Experienced and competent Commeccs College faculty members communicate with students and provide valuable advice and guidance to them.



## Students' Academic & Developmental Support

**Uninterrupted Academic Session:** In an environment where closure of institutions or breakdown of academic sessions is an unfortunate reality, CommeCS College maintains an uninterrupted academic session. A detailed yearly calendar of academic, co/extra-curricular activities and events is given to students at the commencement of the session. Activities are held in accordance with the calendar. CommeCS College has arrangements for solar based alternate power generation other than KE Supply.

**Student Parent Teacher Meetings (PTM):** PTMs are conducted after every internal examination, to inform parents about the student's academic progress, examination result, class participation, discipline, attendance and co-curricular activities. Parents are advised to attend these meetings in order to develop a rapport with the institution for the student's overall development as an individual and a responsible citizen of the country.



**Quality Assurance:** CommeCS College Management takes measures for maintaining quality education. Academic audit of educational services is carried out by a third party. The process starts with class observations, resource material, Examination assessments strategies, faculty development and students satisfaction. Teachers prepare portfolios containing lesson plans with short and long term planning, record of question papers, assessments, remedial measures, support material, personal evaluation and academic achievements to identify strengths and weaknesses of students. The purpose of this exercise is to assure quality in academic process.

## Performance Awards

**Student of the Year:** To stimulate the academic interest, students are encouraged to participate in various activities- academic and non academic. On the basis of these achievements, outstanding performers (Boy and Girl) are honoured by “Student of the Year” awards.

## Performance Awards

It includes assessment of academic services, examination results, personal development, students and peers feedback and co/extra curricular participation. On the basis of this, the best performing faculty member is honoured as “Teacher of the Year” and is awarded a shield.



**Admin Member of the Year:** Best member out of non-teaching staff is selected on the basis of annual all-round performance. He is honoured as “Admin Member of the Year” and awarded with a shield.



## Information Technology

### **IT Infrastructure:**

Students of CommeCS are encouraged to learn computer applications.

### **Microsoft Compliant Institute:**

CommeCS College is Microsoft Compliant Institute. It purchases licensed software and each year a big amount is spent in updating software, enabling the use of latest versions of Windows Operating System and Microsoft Office.

### **Wifi Network & Local Area Network:**

CommeCS LAN consists of eight dedicated servers and 140 modern terminals at Computer Lab,



Library, Faculty Rooms, Principal's Room, Admissions Department, Examination Department, Accounts Department and Administration Department. All the terminals are connected to the Internet through high-speed Fiber Optic Network to motivate students to undertake research based projects and assignment. Wifi internet is provided in all offices and class rooms.

### **Computer Courses**

Realizing the importance of computer applications, CommeCS College offers various short courses to students over the weekends.



## Information Technology

### Computer Lab:

To provide practical and research facilities, the computer lab accommodates 50 students at a time for hands-on classes. The computer lab is also equipped with printers, scanners, multimedia projector and sound system.

## Scholarships and Financial Assistance

### Merit Scholarship Policy:

Students of each discipline will be divided in 02 groups as given below and top 3% students from each group calculated separately for each discipline will be awarded 100% scholarship in **Tuition Fee** as under:

**b. Minimum eligibility marks to contest for the merit scholarships are:**

- 88% and above marks in Karachi and other matric stream boards.
- 85% and above marks in Cambridge, Edexcel, Aga Khan and Federal Boards.
- 85% and above in BIEK 1<sup>st</sup> Year.



## Scholarships and Financial Assistance

**Conditions:** The scholarships amount awarded on merit to student would be continued if the student meets conditions given below:

**Continuation of Merit Scholarship:**

- a. Minimum **80%** in Mid Term Examination results.
- b. Minimum **90%** Attendance till Mid Term Examination.

If the above conditions are not met, 50% deduction in the approved Scholarship amount will be done. **However, in case of any disciplinary issue 100% Scholarship amount may be cancelled.**

A student can avail either Need Based Scholarship or Merit Scholarship. However, if a student is availing Need Based Scholarship and earns Merit Scholarship of amount higher than the need based scholarship, he/she may opt for Merit Scholarship and withdraw from Need Based Scholarship.



## Scholarships and Financial Assistance

### Need Based Scholarship Policy:

COMMECS College offers **Need Based Scholarship on Need cum Merit basis** to students facing financial hardship. Strict confidentiality is maintained. CommeCS College Need Based Scholarship is tied to the results, attendance and disciplinary record. If a student fails to perform satisfactorily in any of the above, the Need Based Scholarship facility may be withdrawn with immediate effect. The decision to grant or refuse Need Based Scholarship is the sole discretion of the Managing Committee.

### 1<sup>st</sup> Year

#### Eligibility Criteria:

- **Parent's income from all sources upto Rs.175,000/- per month.**
- Minimum **60%** marks in Matric / Equivalent for Commerce.
- Minimum **65%** marks in Matric / Equivalent for Pre-Engineering, Computer Science & Pre - Medical Group.

#### NBS Continuation Criteria:

- Minimum **70%** marks in Mid Term Examination..
  - Minimum **90%** Attendance till Mid Term Examination.
- If the above conditions are not met, 50% deduction in the approved amount will be done. However, in case of any disciplinary issue 100% approved amount may be cancelled.



## Scholarships and Financial Assistance

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Year

#### Eligibility Criteria:

- **Parent's income from all sources upto Rs.175,000/- per month..**
- Minimum **70%** marks in Prelim Exam of 1st year.
- Minimum **85%** Attendance in 1st year.
- No discipline issue in 1st year.

#### NBS Continuation Criteria:

- Minimum **70%** marks in Mid Term Examination.
- Minimum **90%** Attendance till Mid Term Examination.

If the above conditions are not met, 50% deduction in the approved amount will be done. However, in case of any disciplinary issue 100% approved amount may be cancelled.

**100% Freeship:** 7% of students to get 100% Need Based Scholarship for Tuition Fee only (including deserving orphans / ward of single parent (mother) / divorced mother (not supported by father)). Number of students equivalent to 7% of the total strength will be chosen from those topping the Need Based Scholarship point table. Rest of the students will be awarded as per their earned score on points table.

**Evaluation:** After receipt of the need based scholarship applications, the committee will evaluate/assess the applicants documents as per the laid down criteria The successful applicants will be intimated the amount of Need Based Scholarship approved for the year subject to fulfillment of the under mentioned conditions in two stages:

**Note:** *Need Based Scholarship will be granted on Tuition Fee only.*



# Scholarships and Financial Assistance

## Midterm Excellence Scholarship Policy:

Midterm Performance-Based Merit Scholarship is available ONLY to those students who are NOT availing Need Based Scholarship (NBS) / Merit Based Scholarship (MBS) or Sibling / Alumni discounts.

To qualify for the Midterm Excellence Scholarship, a student must fulfill the following conditions:

### 2. Scholarship Award & Continuation:

50% of scholarship will be awarded on Mid Term result.

Remaining 50% will be awarded on Prelims result subject to meeting the criteria of minimum 75% marks & 90% attendance in Preliminary Examination.



## Scholarships and Financial Assistance

### **Siblings Concession:**

- 25% Concession in Tuition Fee to students whose brother (s) / sister (s) is/are studying in CommeCS College in the same academic year.
- 25% Concession in Tuition Fee will be offered to 02 siblings if 03 or more are studying in the same academic year.

### **Fee Payment Policy:**

- Accounts department will issue fee vouchers by 5th of each month.
- Due date to pay the fee will be 10 days.
- A penalty of Rs.1,000/- will be imposed, if the fee is not paid within due date.
- Vouchers will be valid till last day of each month.
- If the fee is not paid for consecutive two months, the admission will be cancelled.
- Students can, however, be readmitted on submitting the written request from the parents, subject to approval by the management and payment of readmission fee of Rs. 10,000/- and the outstanding fee.

## Academic and Disciplinary Requirements

### **Punctuality:**

College starts at 7:45 a.m. and closes at 3:00 p.m. However, this timing may change as per timetable, if needed. Classes are held from Monday to Saturday. Punctuality is highly stressed. College gates are closed at 8:00 a.m. sharp. Students reaching late are not allowed to enter the college premises. Students are required to attend the morning assembly every day

### **Uniform:**

#### **Boys:**

Grey trousers (specific shade), white shirt with College logo, navy blue tie with College logo, black waist belt, plain black shoes and black socks. During winters, boys may wear navy blue pullover with College logo or navy blue blazer with blue buttons and College logo.

#### **Girls:**

White shirt with College logo, white shalwar, plain black shoes with black socks and light grey dupatta (specific shade).

Girls using a scarf to cover their heads are allowed to use black scarves only. During winters, girls may wear a navy blue pullover with College logo.

Students are not allowed to wear caps in the campus, or any other article of clothing or jewellery, that is considered improper as per College rules and regulations.

#### **Code of Conduct:**

Students are required to observe proper decorum throughout their stay in accordance with the code of conduct.

#### **College ID Card:**

Students are to wear College ID Card all the time at the campus.



Smoking is strictly prohibited. Mobile phone is not allowed within the premises.



## Academic and Disciplinary Requirements

### Attendance:

**75%** attendance is compulsory, without which a student is not allowed to appear in the final exams as a Commecs College student.

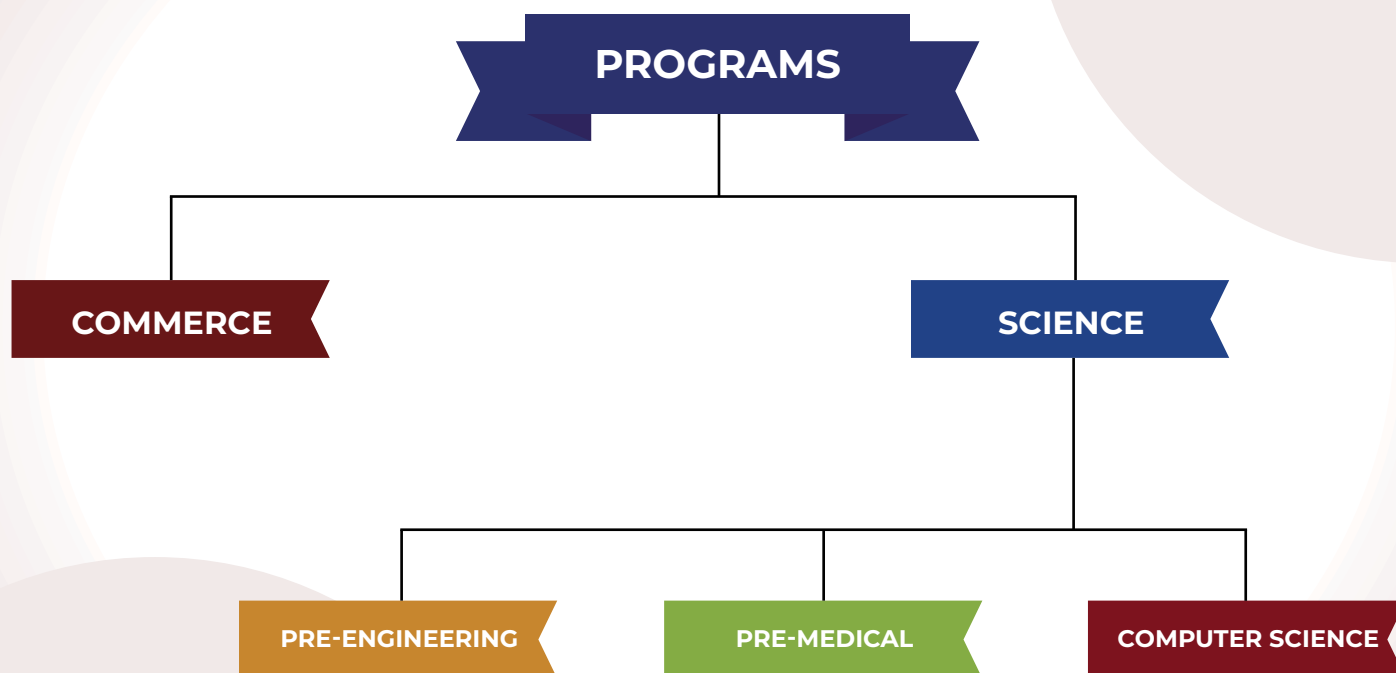
### Leave Rules:

- A student who is absent from college for a day or more must provide an application for leave from parents on the very first day back to college.
- Leave is to be applied only under inevitable circumstances.
- Leave for reason other than sudden illness must be applied well before time.
- For sick leave, medical evidence will be required.
- Absence without leave application for 15 days or more makes a student liable for withdrawal from college.

## Academic Programs

### **Commerce:**

Commerce is the pioneering discipline of CommeCS College. The program started in 1993 and its first batch of H.S.C. Commerce passed out in 1995. Commerce education is an invaluable course of studies for students who are looking forward to careers in the business, economics, banking and finance sectors. The program also focuses on personal development by helping students nurture their leadership abilities while developing important problem-solving techniques necessary to face today's challenges. Students taking up Commerce Group can lead themselves to careers in Chartered Accountancy, Cost and Management Accountancy, Business Administration, Economic Affairs, Business Analytics, Actuarial Science, Investment & Banking.

### **Pre-Engineering:**

Pre Engineering program provides a foundation for higher studies in the engineering field students aspire to join it. It is important for those who want to pursue their careers in the fields of Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry and related sub fields.

To earn a Pre Engineering qualification, a student has to have a mind for mathematics and hence quantitative reasoning. An aptitude for sciences along with liking for mathematics is required in order to do well and achieve the desired qualification in good grades.

Some top picks for career option after Pre Engineering in Pakistan are Computer Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Aerospace Engineering, Aeronautical Engineering, Robotics Engineering, Petroleum and Gas Engineering, Bio Medical Engineering, Nuclear Engineering and Software Engineers.

### Examination Code of Conduct:

Commeccs College has a code of conduct at all levels. Strict disciplinary action, which may even lead to cancellation of admission, is taken against any student for cheating or using any unfair means during the examinations.

### Unsatisfactory Performance:

Commeccs College reserves the right to withhold examination forms of poor performers and absentees of internal examinations. Such students are required to show an improvement in their performance and may be called to the college for remedial teaching on Saturdays.





## Admission Process

CommeCS College announces its admissions to class XI every year on social media and on its website. Applicants are required to follow instructions given in college brochure while undergoing the admission process.

### Admission Criteria:

Provisional admission is given on the basis of merit determined through candidate's result of SSC-Part I or its equivalent examinations, admission test and interview. Admission at CommeCS College is strictly merit based; any recommendation and / or influence to secure admission will result in disqualification of the candidate. The merit assessment comprises:

- Previous Scholastic Achievement
- CommeCS Admission Test (CAT)
- Interview

### ELIGIBILITY:

#### Academic Requirement:

- **65%** and above in SSC examinations or equivalent for Pre-Engineering, Pre-Medical and Computer Science candidates.
- **60%** and above in SSC examinations or equivalent for Commerce group.
- Candidates with Cambridge background are required to clear 8 papers with 4 compulsory papers (Urdu, English, Pakistan Studies and Islamiat) and one Mathematics paper from optional subjects.
- Candidates with SSC General Group are NOT eligible to apply for admission in Science Group (Pre-Engineering, Pre-Medical and Computer Science).
- Candidates who have studied Computer Studies in lieu of Biology in SSC or its equivalent examination are NOT eligible to apply for admission in Pre-Medical Group.
- Candidates who have not studied Biology / Computer Science in O' Level Examination are not eligible to apply for admission in science (Pre-Engineering or Pre-Medical groups respectively).



## Admission Process

### Age Limit:

- Applicants must not be above 18 years of age as on August 01, 2025.
- Relaxation up to **1.5** year is given to Huffaz-e-Quran (candidates are required to show their “Sanad”)

- Photocopy of B-Form.
- Photocopy of SSC-I Marksheet.
- Photocopy of SSC-II Admit Card / Statement of Entry.
- Passport size photographs.



## Admission Process

### Commeccs Admission Test (CAT)

Applicants are required to take the Computer-Based Admission Test irrespective of their previous system of education which provides a fair measure of candidates' scholastic attainment as well as an insight into their potential. To assess diverse set of knowledge needed for different disciplines, separate Computer based admission tests are designed for Science and Commerce candidates to assess applicants' skills in the following areas:

## Admission Process

### Interview:

Applicants who succeed in the CommeCS Admission Test are invited for an interview. The interview is conducted by a panel comprising senior faculty members to assess knowledge, communication skills, confidence and response patterns of the candidates. Presence of the parents or guardian is compulsory during the interview.

### Merit List:

The selection of the candidate depends on the cumulative score of the Previous Scholastic Achievement, CAT score and marks in the Interview. The final admission list is announced on the website.

### Confirmation of Provisional Admission:

After the declaration of annual result of SSC or its equivalent examinations by the respective board / university, provisional admission of only those students will be confirmed who have:

- Secured a minimum of **65%** aggregate marks in Pre-Engineering, Pre-Medical and Computer Science groups.
- Secured a minimum of **60%** aggregate marks in Commerce and Humanities groups.
- Obtained equivalence certificate from Inter Board Committee of Chairman (IBCC) for O' Level students.

The original Mark Sheet / Statement of Results of examinations should be submitted to CommeCS College Admission Department within 15 days of the declaration of results by the board / university.

### Documents Required

#### Documents to be submitted by the Cambridge Board Students:

- Equivalence Certificate.
- Permission for Regularization of Admission (PRA)

*For non submission of the above documents, provisional admission would neither be confirmed nor regularized.*



## Admission Process

### Documents to be Submitted by the Candidates from Boards other than Karachi:

- Original Migration Certificate.
- Permission for Change of Board – PCB

*In case of non submission of the above documents, provisional admission would neither be confirmed nor regularized*

### Admission Withdrawal / Cancellation:

- In case of withdrawal from the college by the student due to any reason whatsoever, no fee under any circumstances, will be refunded. However.

*Only in the case of cancellation of admission due to the candidate being unable to meet the admission criteria, the fee will be refunded.*

- If the student is involved in any Disciplinary matter, the admission of the student can be cancelled
- Commeccs College Management monitors the academic performance of the students through their internal examination system. In case, student's performance in internal examination is poor in the Mid Terms, his / her admission may be cancelled.

### Admission to the Second Year:

Students clearing their first year will not be automatically eligible for admission to the second year; they are required to seek re-admission through a fresh process which will require the following:

- Academic performance during internal examinations (Mid Term and Preliminary Examination) of the first year.
- Satisfactory behaviour and discipline.
- Minimum **75%** attendance in XI.

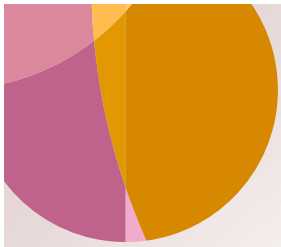

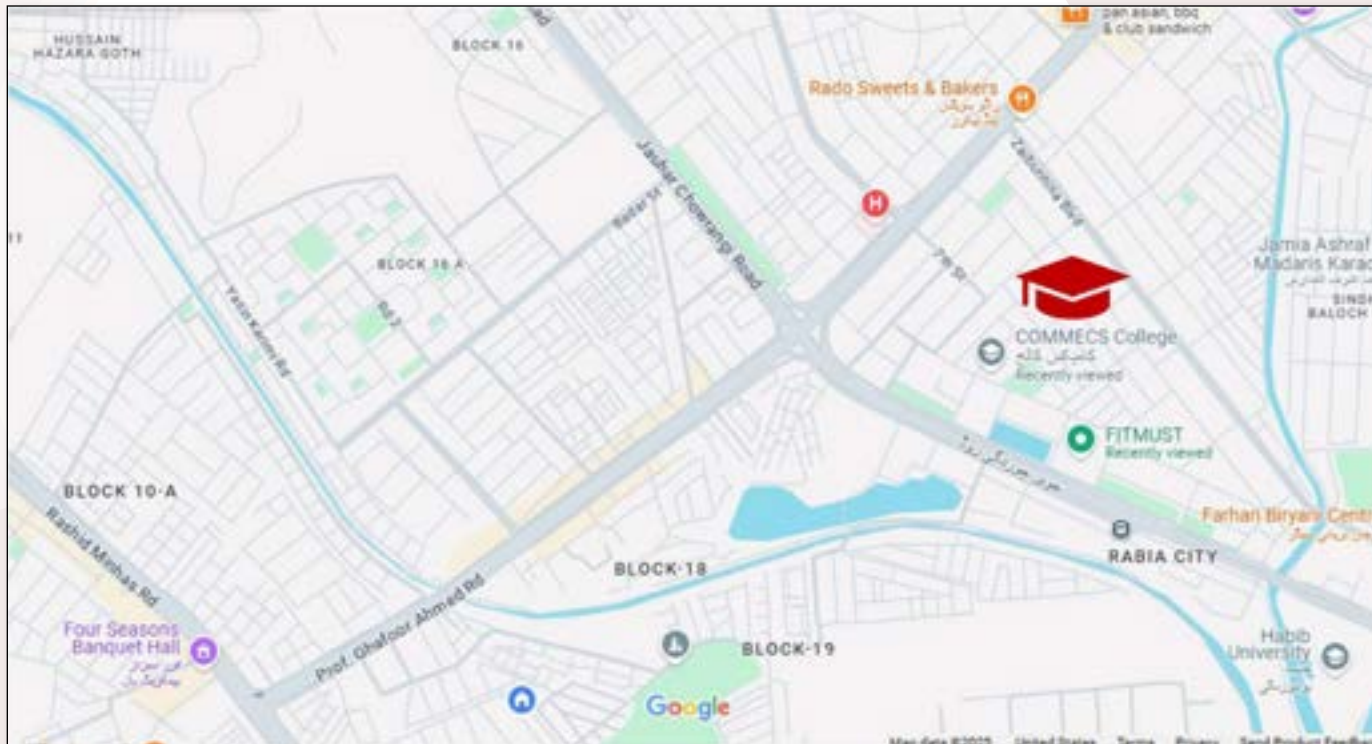
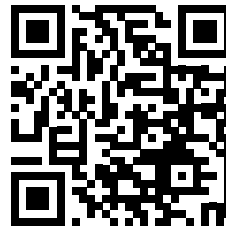
